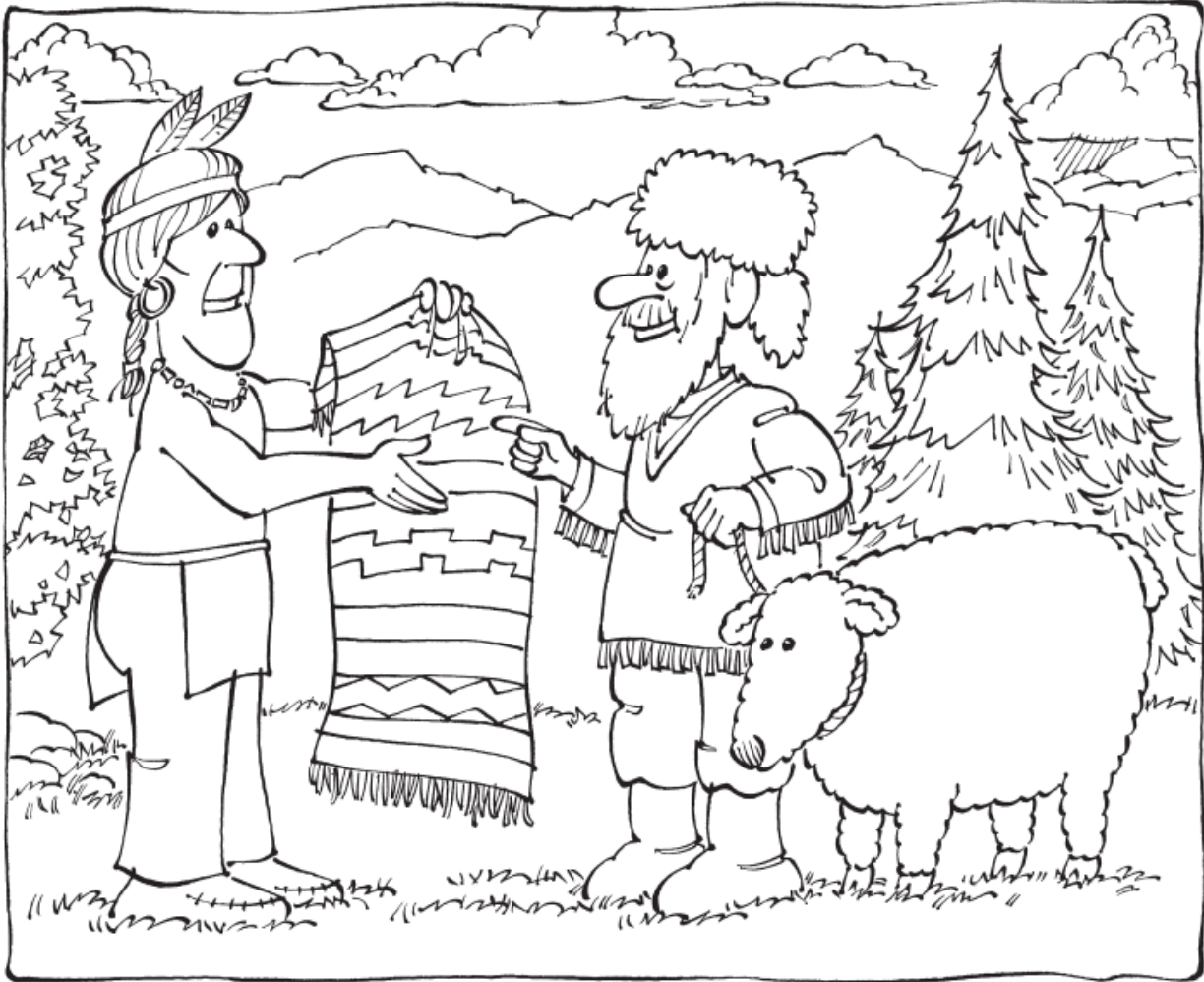


A long time ago, people didn't use money ... they traded
